FINANCIAL INCENTIVES and BUSINESS ASSISTANCE SERVICES

New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYCEDC) can help you determine if you qualify for valuable programs like tax-exempt financing, employee recruitment and training services, and other business resources.

Programs Include:

Commercial Expansion Program

The Commercial Expansion Program (CEP) is a package of tax benefits designed to help qualified businesses relocate and expand within designated expansion areas throughout New York City. CEP includes modifications to The Industrial and Commercial Incentive Program (ICIP) and rent abatements for commercial and industrial tenants.

Energy Discount Programs

NYCEDC administers numerous energy discount programs that may help your business operate more efficiently and productively.

For example, with the Energy Cost Savings Program, the delivery component of electricity bills can be reduced by 45 percent and the delivery component of natural gas bills can be reduced by 35 percent.

Any business located at BAT may apply to be certified as a Qualified Empire Zone Enterprise and become eligible for enhanced sales, property and business tax credits.

Shipping and distribution outlets

BAT is served by major highways and freight railroads, allowing tenants to easily ship goods and materials. Each leasable space has access to numerous free service elevators and loading docks.

Flexibility in every space

Tenants may modify any space at BAT to meet their specific needs. Units have been redesigned for a variety of uses such as manufacturing, warehousing, showrooms and office space. Individual units range from 4,500 to 39,000 square feet, with up to 200,000 square feet of available contiguous developable space.



ACCESSIBILITY

BAT's convenient location puts you and your employees in close proximity to Manhattan and the other boroughs, major highways and metro area airports.

By mass transit:

The N and R subway lines stop just blocks from BAT at Fourth Avenue and 59th Street in Sunset Park. Three MTA bus lines - the B9, B11 and B37 - also service the area.

By ferry:

New York Water Taxi provides ferry service between Pier 11 (at the foot of Wall Street in Manhattan) and BAT during the morning and evening rush hours.

By car:

BAT is less than 20 minutes from Manhattan via the Gowanus Expressway and either the Brooklyn Bridge or the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel. The facility offers easy access to Staten Island and New Jersey via the nearby Verrazano Bridge, and to John F. Kennedy International Airport and Long Island via the Belt Parkway. BAT has secure, on-site parking for 2,000 vehicles.

Location:

BAT is located in the Sunset Park section of Brooklyn. This community's residential area is the largest federally-designated historic district in the Northeastern United States. The neighborhood offers affordable housing, excellent medical facilities, parks, schools, houses of worship and a wide variety of shopping and dining amenities.


